

SAFE TRAVEL CHECKLIST

Before You Go

Call the Hotel

Ask if CO detectors are installed in both rooms and public areas. Also ask if they are routinely tested to ensure proper functioning, either with working batteries or reliable hardwiring.

Know Local Laws

Research CO detector requirements in your destination's country or state.

Research CO Incidents

Check for past CO safety issues at the hotel or in the area.

Pack a CO Detector

Bring a portable, battery-powered CO detector for added security.

Once You Arrive

Install Your CO Detector

Place it in your room, away from vents or windows.

Check Room Ventilation

Ensure proper ventilation and avoid blocking vents.

Identify Exits

Be aware of emergency exits and your room's location.
